Will participate in deployed communications exercises in field conditions. This is a worldwide mobility position. Unit is stationed on Fairchild AFB.

<p>Assigned to the Plans and Resources Flight, Power Production Work Center (CTCP). Deploy and sustain power generating equipment and associated systems to provide electrical power for deployable communications and data processing facilities. Perform installation, testing, operation, maintenance, and repair of facilities, systems, equipment, and subsystems. Perform preventive and scheduled maintenance on equipment, overhauls, and modifications. Adjust engine generator systems to maintain proper voltage, current, frequency, and synchronization. Evaluate equipment performance. Operates high/low voltage switches, circuit breakers, rheostats, and other controls on switch gear and distribution panels. Schedules training for RSD weekends for all assigned Guardsmen. Certifies task qualification for Power Production career development and overall readiness of assigned traditional guardsmen in Air Force Training Record (AFTR). Assist subordinates in reaching their full potential. Responsible for their subordinates' development and the effective accomplishment of all assigned tasks, ensure proper and effective use of all resources under the control to ensure the mission effectively and efficiently accomplished. Promote a culture of airmen who are capable of mastering multiple tasks to better support mission requirements.</p>
